# **2021 International Thank A Superintendent Tactics**

GCSAA has been recognizing its members with an annual "Thank a Superintendent" event since 2015. The expansion of the celebration to an international day to celebrate superintendents and greenkeepers worldwide was well received and built a solid foundation upon which to grow the international participation and recognition. With golf being one of the few success stories of the pandemic, the 2021 event will be designed to include a greater emphasis on the global golf community and increased opportunities for courses and golfers to be a part of the celebration

The next International Thank a Superintendent/Thank a Greenkeeper Day is scheduled for Sept. 14, 2021, but global partners will be asked to provide assets and materials as part of the creative collateral in the months and weeks leading up to the celebration. GCSAA will then distribute the final collateral pieces, which can be customized to fit each country's/association's specific needs, by Aug. 1 in preparation for the global event.

The elements, requested material and deadlines are as follows:

#### **30-second Television Commercial**

- Concept: Two-section piece with 10-15 seconds focused on highlighting the work and dedication of the superintendent profession and then the remainder of the time featuring video messages of "thanks" from golfers. Footage for this second section will be gathered through combined efforts of GCSAA and international partners, with thanks being said in various languages and accents. Would include professional golfers as well as recreational golfers. Each country/association would provide video of 1 profession and 5-10 recreational golfers.
- Estimated delivery of commercial to partners for customization: August 1
- Commercial debuts: on September 14
- Ask: Each association will submit 3-5 videos of golfers saying "Thank You". They may be professionals, first timers, kids, etc. "Thank You" may be in any language. Please include the name and city/country of the golfer. Videos can be submitted to a Dropbox that EPIC Creative will provide. Any format is fine, but please send highest resolution possible.

#### **Social Media Tool Kit for Associations**

- Tool kit of suggested social posts for #thankasuper and #thankagreenkeeper campaign.
- All international partners would provide images to be shared with all groups. Images would identify golf course and country of origin.

We would like to have as many associations represented as possible, so wherever members of other organizations can be used instead of GCSAA, please do so. It's also fine if a person is a member of multiple associations.
- Ask: Each association will recruit and identify one member in each of the time zones they represent. We need the name, title, course name, which association, Twitter handle (if they have one) and an image of each person or their course. GCSAA will include the hourly profile the in Social Media Tool Kit.
